Jesus Came to Paint a Different Picture!

Have you ever been in a conversation with somebody where you felt like you were just "talking past each other"? Do you know what I mean? It's like you're saying something ... but they're hearing something else ... and they say something, but you don't understand—it happens a lot when people are trying to give directions. Or have you ever just gotten to the place where you said: "Do you want me to draw you a picture?" I reckon Jesus was at that point when He rode into Jerusalem on a colt of a donkey—I reckon He felt like he had done all he could do. He had healed the



sick ... He had made the blind see again ... He had fed hungry multitudes ... He had touched lepers and cast out demons—isn't that what the Messiah was all about? Healing and restoration and deliverance? And yet the disciples and the crowds had their eyes open for a warrior ... a rebel ... somebody to lead the revolt against those hated Romans. I reckon Jesus had gotten to the point where he just wanted to say: "Do you want me to draw you a picture of why I'm here?"—and He actually did.

And so ... dramatically ... and visibly ... and clearly, Jesus arranged for the words of the prophet Zechariah to be fulfilled Zechariah, who many years before had said: "Rejoice, O daughter of Zion! Shout! Your king comes to you – triumphant and victorious is he, humble and riding on a colt, the foal of a donkey." News From GS Treasurer

At the Half Yearly Meeting in November 2023, the following resolution was passed. "Pending further research and a collaborative approach (with the District), to consider the role/amount of the District contribution and LCA Transfer Fund (to the LCA), to the function and life of the church, and to report back to the congregation". The Transfer Fund is known by the District as the Pastors Transfer and Support Fund.

Its purpose is set out in the District Guideline as follows:

• The fund provides for the cost of a Pastor, his family, and his goods from one parish to another, and pastoral care to a parish during a vacancy.

During a parish vacancy the Fund bears the cost of:

- The salary and applicable allowances payable to a locum or relief Pastor who is serving in a vacant parish.
- Remuneration for services conducted by relief Pastors and their travel expenses to and from a parish.

Contact has been made with the SA District of the LCA, and a request made by our Board to reduce our contribution to the Pastor Transfer fund by 50%, i.e. from \$3,365.79 per month to \$1,682.89 per month. This has been approved by District Church Council and will be backdated to 1st January 2024.

Sharon Tarca was recently appointed on a part time basis (3 hours per week) to undertake administrative tasks (typically undertaken by a Pastor), associated with ministry, and the SA District Board agreed that her salary will be paid out of the Transfer Fund, backdated to her starting date in December 2023.


